

## World Jewelry Center to open in Las Vegas in 2010

The World Jewelry Center in Las Vegas has received commitments from its first ten tenants. The project, which is scheduled to be completed in early 2010, is expected to be one of the biggest mixed use jewelry spaces in the world. The Center will have one million square feet, making it one of the tallest structures in Nevada.

The Center will cater to domestic and international retailers, manufacturers, dealers, and wholesalers. Building features include state of the art security, secure shipping and receiving, gem grading labs and educational facilities, trade associations, and plans for a dedicated Foreign Trade Zone.

The luxury space will also house residential condominiums, restaurants, fitness center, and exhibition facilities. An adjacent three story building will house retail shops and a world-class gem and jewelry museum.
